Project Information

Description: Volunteers are asked recycle cassette tapes recorded for and used by the visually, physically and reading disabled customers of the library. These tapes need to be removed from their containers with the tapes placed in one large container and tape mailing boxes placed in another.

Who will benefit: Over 39,000 visually and physically impaired citizens of FL

Long Term Impact: These Florida citizens will be able to read on a continuing basis, plus an increase the availability of Library materials to our customers and increase the number of materials.

Agency to provide: all work materials and supplies will be furnished. Coffee and refreshments will be served.

Volunteer Needs

Number of Volunteers Needed Minimum: 25 Maximum: 50

Minimum Age: 16 years of age.

Special Skills or Requirements: All training is given on premises. Good hand/eye coordination and physically able to sort the numbers and put cassettes and boxes in containers. Volunteers will need 2 forms of ID, preferably Driver's License and Social Card, and to pass a Homeland Security background check. These forms must be filled out prior to beginning work.
