Description: New Towels, Lightweight blankets & Linens Drive. The Children's Home Society's Emergency Shelter & Residential Program provides residential shelter for youth removed from their homes and placed in dependency care by the court system because of abuse, neglect or abandonment..

Volunteers will collect items described above.

Who will benefit: Foster Teens & sibling groups living in CHS residential group homes in West Volusia.. Residential group homes work to help the teen's transition from abuse, neglect or abandonment to a better future through encouragement & support, training and continued education. Like any large home linens are used 24/7 and are in need of replacement very often.

Long Term Impact: Teenagers living in foster care usually have been in care the longest and have far more internal and emotional scars from their abuse. A group home allows them to bond with other teens that know what they have been and are going through. An environment of a caring and support in their surroundings can help heal, encourage and build their self esteem. Each youth has their own area (some for the first time) and take pride in that. New linens and towels increase the belonging that they feel in their home!
